1. Shall the Contoocook Valley School District raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000,000 (Gross Budget) for the building, renovating, and equipping of Science Labs at ConVal High School, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$1,000,000 of bonds, notes, or loans in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA Chapter 33), and to authorize the Contoocook Valley School Board to issue, negotiate, sell, and deliver such bonds, notes, or loans, and to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof, and to authorize the Contoocook Valley School Board to take any other action or to pass any other vote relative thereto, and to authorize the Contoocook Valley School Board to apply for, obtain, and accept federal, state or other aid, if any, which may be available for the Project and to comply with all laws applicable to said Project, and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$11,722, for the purpose of the first year's interest payment on the bond. (The ConVal School Board designates this article as a SPECIAL warrant article and RECOMMENDS adoption of this article.) (3/5 vote required)

2. Shall the Contoocook Valley School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$45,589,763? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$44,934,209, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Contoocook Valley School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

3. Shall the Contoocook Valley School District accept the findings and recommendations of the Factfinder with respect to the collective bargaining agreement between the Contoocook Valley School Board and the Contoocook Valley Education Association for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,685,912, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increases in salaries, wages and benefits required by the Factfinder's recommendations over those that would be paid at the current staffing levels.
