Tim Theberge opened the public hearings at 7:01 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

In accordance with RSA 198:20-c,II, a public hearing will be held by the Contoocook Valley School Board for the purpose of expending funds from the ConVal Building Capital Reserve Fund for the 2021-2022 fiscal year to conduct an engineering study for Great Brook School and South Meadow School.

Tim Theberge reported that this request is to support an engineering study for \$160,000 for work needed at both Great Brook School and South Meadow School.

After hearing no public comment, the Public Hearing was closed.

Stephen Ullman moved to approve the request to expend funds as outlined. Greg Kriebel second. Unanimous.

In accordance with RSA 198:20-b, a public hearing will be held by the Contoocook Valley School Board for the purpose of accepting the unanticipated ESSER funds for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Lori Schmidt said that \$1.4M is allocated. She recommended accepting up to \$1.5M.

After hearing no public comment, the Public Hearing was closed.

Stephen Ullman moved to accept up to \$1.5M in ESSER Funds. Greg Kriebel second. Unanimous.

In accordance with RSA 198:20-b, a public hearing will be held by the Contoocook Valley School Board for the purpose of expending funds from the Daniels Fund - Hancock to build a pavilion at Hancock Elementary School in the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

The recommendation is to expend up to \$85,000, to account for fluctuations in pricing, for the pavilion and playground upgrades.

**Stephen Ullman moved to expend up to \$85,000 for a pavilion at Hancock Elementary School and playground updates.
Greg Kriebel second.**

Greg Kriebel asked how much was spent on the Dublin Pavilion. Kimberly Saunders reported that \$20,000 in materials not including donated time and labor.

Unanimous.

Tim Theberge closed the Public Hearing, after hearing no public comment, at 7:06 p.m.
